Luminous pollution has many documented negative effects on the environment and the health of the beings that live in it. These effects are still little known to the general public because this field of study is developed only in the last decade, while the effect on the night sky was detected by sensitive instruments of astronomers already in the IX century and was studied from the first years of the seventies when, precisely in Italy, the first map of artificial luminosity was made.



There are hundreds of studies and reports that document the effects of artificial light on the environment and understand the alteration of life habits and hunting of animals, disturbances to reproduction and migrations, alteration of circadian rhythms, alterations in photosynthesis of plants and in photoperiodism, and for humans, glare, myopia and hormonal alterations capable of reducing our defenses against tumors.
